to this hour, there has never been even one white woman captured by Indians who has not later been made a victim of maddening bodily outrage. No wonder, then, they have dobuted these Armenian tales of horror. first begun by Armenian revolutionists. That is not the slightest excuse for the Turkish barbarities. No kind of provocation in rebellion toward political authority or contempt of established religion can

be admitted as excuse or palliation for such deeds as the Turks appear to have committed.

It is the manifest duty of civilization, independent of any treaty obligation, to

deeds of this kind must be stopped by it, or it must be wiped out of existence, and replaced by a government that will keep at least within hailing distance of decent civilization. This demand must be made not because they are Turks, nor because they are Mohammedans. That the deeds are done in the name of religion only makes them more revolting. The demand must be made because these people are savages, and in the name of our common humanity. If savages exercising savagery

bound to respect, except as its own selfrespect prompts, then civilization is a delusion and a cheat, and there is no mission for it on earth or elsewhere.
