TURKS ATTACK FOREIGNERS.

American Minister Terrell Urges the Porte to Increase the Police Force

in Constantinople.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Feb. 8.—Owing to recent attacks upon foreigners, United States Minister Terrell has urged the Porte to increase the force of police in this city.

The Porte has finally decided to permit newspaper reporters to travel in all the provinces of Asia Minor except in Bitlis, while the commission of inquiry

is sitting at Moosh.

The Armenian commission is still examining witnesses at Moosh. The local authorities are hampering the foreign delegates, who, therefore, insist that the Porte enable them to obtain certain evidence they want.
