

Brutal Assault on One of the Men Concerned in the Providence Riot.

PROVIDENCE, R I, Sept 24—The police are investigating the anarchism among the Armenian colonists in this city, and they have learned that there is a most dangerous class among those located on Federal hill.

Tonight one of the eight men arrested in the riot in the Armenian hall on Exchange pl, and fined this morning, was followed as he went to his home and knocked senseless with a paving stone. The assailant was chased from ambush and followed quite a distance by citizens, but he got away.

The injured Armenian was taken care of by the police, and doctors were called, who pronounced the wound a serious one. Some of the more reputable anarchists have told the police the whole tale of the anarchist movement here, and they are fearful about their own safety unless they join the ultra-anarchist group.

The police also received a dispatch from the Lynn authorities tonight, asking them to hold Nixson Garibedian of Lynn, and saying he was a most dangerous man and that he was wanted on a certain charge in Lynn.

The police here, however, did not see Garibedian at the riot in the Exchange hall, for he hid and eluded them when they quelled the bloody encounter.

The police are of the firm opinion that the Armenian anarchists are the worst type of dynamite howlers, and that future meetings will be broken up.
