

SULTAN FINDS NO FRIEND.

**Kaiser and French President Said
to Have Refused to Help Him.**

LONDON, Sept. 2—4 A. M.—A Constantinople despatch reports that the Ministers have met at the palace on three successive evenings, remaining until midnight, to discuss Armenia.

Emperor William, it is said, has been asked to intervene, but declined on the ground that the Porte had already disregarded his advice to introduce reform.

Then President Faure was approached, but declined to act except in concert of the Powers.
