In Open Letter Frenchmen Exhort
President Wilson to Prevent
Further Persecution.

The Ligue des Droits de l'Homme and the Franco-Armenian Committee are addressing an open letter to Mr. Woodrow Wilson, in which they call the President's attention to the deplorable condition of the Armenians in Turkey and appeal to the American people and its Government to save what remains of the unfortunate nation.

The writers say that American missions have accomplished marvellous effects of charity with their works of aid and instruction for Armenians, and that France is powerless now to prevent the cruelties of the Young Turks, who are continuing the work of destruction begun by Abdul Hamid under German influence.
