## **THREE HUNDRED PERISHED.**

**Bulgarians Used Dynamite Bombs  
in the Attack on Dospat.**

CONSTANTINOPLE, Aug. 28.—Three hundred persons perished, it is reported, as the result of the recent attack by Bulgarians on the Mahometan village of Dospat, across the Turkish frontier.

The attack, it appears, was made at dawn, while the villagers were asleep. The Bulgarians used dynamite bombs and set fire to the houses.

When the inhabitants tried to escape, men, women and children, it is alleged, were killed indiscriminately.
