THREE HUNDRED PERISHED.

Bulgarians Used Dynamite Bombs in the Attack on Dospat.

Petersburg bitterly complaining that

CONSTANTINOPLE, Aug. 28.—Three hundred persons perished, it is reported as the result of the recent attack by Bulgarians on the Mahometan village of Dospat, across the Turkish frontier. The attack, it appears, was made at

dawn, while the villagers were asleed. The Bulgarians used dynamite bombs and set fire to the houses. When the inhabitants tried to escape, men, women and children, it is alleged, were killed indiscriminately.
