

HEWITT WOULD AID THE TURKS.

The Sultan Helped Johnstown Sufferers,
So We Should Reciprocate.

Ex-Mayor Abram S. Hewitt has written a letter to A. E. Orr, President of the Chamber of Commerce, asking that subscriptions be received by the chamber towards the relief of the earthquake-stricken inhabitants of Constantinople.

Mr. Hewitt in his letter points out that after the Johnstown disaster the first substantial subscription came from His Majesty the Sultan of Turkey, who thus showed not only his friendly feeling towards this country but his knowledge of current events in other portions of the world. His Majesty must, therefore, be somewhat surprised, if not hurt, by the apparent indifference of our people to the ruin and suffering caused by the recent succession of earthquakes in Constantinople.
