RAN AMUCK, KILLING THREE.

An American Among the Men Slain by a Frenzied Assassin in Constantinople.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Jan. 31.-A man armed with a knife ran amuck last night through the streets in the Pancaldi quarter. He cut, stabbed or slashed every person within whose reach he came. A Turkish official, a railway employee and an American citizen were killed, while about ten others were more or less seriously wounded. There was no provocation for the killing and wounding, and it is believed that the assassin was attacked with a sudden frenzy of murder. The murderer made his escape.
