

A BIG CROWD HEARD HIM.

Nishan Garabedian Says he Abhors Anarchists.

The first annual meeting of delegates from the different Armenian branches of the Armenian Huntchagist revolutionary party, was held in Grange hall yesterday morning, afternoon and evening. Delegates were present from branches of the organization in New York, Chicago, Philadelphia, Lawrence, Haverhill, Fitchburg, Lynn, Providence, Lowell, Salem, Fall River, Whitinsville, Woonsocket and one or two other New England towns. The morning and afternoon sessions were held privately by the delegates and were rather brief, as far as the transaction of business went, for they developed into social reunions rather than business meetings.

In the evening, the hall was crowded to the doors. It was close and disagreeable inside, but that did not at all hinder Nishan Garabedian of Boston from delivering a vigorous eloquent address, in which he denounced anarchy and anarchists, placed himself on record as abhorring the assassin of President Carnot and stated that anarchistic principles are directly opposed to the principles of socialism.
