The language used by Lord Salisbury on the subject of the Armenian atrocities, in what is known as the Queen's speech, is probably the strongest employed in such a document in the lifetime of the present sovereign. That a Conservative Premier, who was joined with Lord BEACONSFIELD in protecting the Turk at the Berlin Conference, should use words which might have been uttered by Mr. GLADSTONE himself makes things look blue for the Sultan. The

self makes things look blue for the Sultan. The policy of the new administration will have the active support of the Liberal minority in Parliament. There seems to be no doubt now that the Christians of Asia Minor will be virtually taken from under the active control of the bloodthirsty infidel.
