

ARMENIAN INQUIRY TO BE SLOW.

European Delegates Not Allowed to Take
Along with Them, It Is Reported,
Any Armenian Interpreter.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Feb. 14. — The Turkish commission of inquiry into massacres of Armenians has held twelve sittings at Moosh. As soon as the examination of witnesses there is finished, it will visit the Sassoun district villages. The commission's work will continue some months.

The British Embassy here has learned that of the Armenians tried at Erzingen twenty were sentenced to death and twenty-seven to various terms of imprisonment, six of them for life. The Court has assured the British Government that before these sentences are carried out all the proceedings in the cases will be carefully reviewed.

BOSTON, Feb. 14.—Word comes from Erzroom that the European delegates with the Turkish commission of inquiry were not allowed to take Armenian interpreters with them. The Sassoun Armenians know only Koordish and a little Armenian; no Turkish.
