TURKEY BEGINS TO TREMBLE.

Berlin Treaty Powers Will Have Nothing to Say to Her Until They Decide What to Do About Armenia.

VIENNA, Dec. 10.—All foreign diplomatic action at Constantinople has been suspended pending the exchange of views between the Berlin Treaty powers with a view to joint action on the Armenian

question.
