

# FAREWELL TURNS TO FIGHT.

Lynn Armenian Objected to His Compatriots Meeting the Turks.

---

LYNN, Jan. 6.—This morning the Lynn police made a raid on a house in Alley street and found in a small room seventeen Armenians. They were all arrested, charged with playing cards and creating a disturbance. All were bailed out with the exception of one man, who, his companions claim, was the cause of all the disturbance.

From one of the men it was learned that two of the Lynn Armenians are to leave within a few days for their homes in Armenia, there to do what they can toward assisting their countrymen against the Turks. It was for the purpose of bidding them godspeed and giving them encouragement that the company met at the house, and everything was going along peacefully

until an Armenian who was opposed to the departure of his fellow countrymen for the other side made his appearance.

Immediately a free fight began, and chairs, knives and clubs were used promiscuously, with the result that several of the band are suffering with broken heads, blacked eyes and small cuts. The neighbors thought murder was being done in the house and notified the police.
